Business

Heart & Sole 5K/10K was a fun event with ~10 participants. Good turnout considering Covid precautions continue.

Matt just led a bike maintenance clinic prior to the meeting.

Upcoming events:

Bike Time Trial-Sunday March 21 at 8am at the Lodge. Becky will lead and it will run like the last time it was held in October. An email was sent out ~2 weeks ago with information and the waiver but no one has registered yet. It is posted on the website and Facebook group page. There will be 40K and 20K options for club members only. Riders will be sent off at 1 minute intervals. Sign up is due back via email by March 20 at 8am.

Tour de Canyon Lake-tentatively scheduled for April 17 at 9am at the Lodge. Karin will lead and will check with the POA if it is an event we can open to the CL community, not just club members. Expressed it is an event that can be done safely as it is all outdoors on bikes. Riders will complete a group ride of one loop around the lake. Participants will be encouraged to bring a donation to get free T-shirt. Proceeds go to Animal Friends of the

Valley. Karin will submit paperwork for approval of this event as well as Pedal-Paddle Regatta (August event) to determine if POA will allow these community wide events.

New Business:

Club Gear-Karin has reached out to tow companies: Wyn Republic and Voler.

Wyn: We need to decide what we want (jerseys, kits, shorts). Each has a different minimum. Must order 5 pieces per item and a 10 item minimum. Can add graphics, sponsors, etc. with their template. If we want to design something custom it is \$300 design fee. Wynrepublic.com

Voler: 15 item minimum but can be mixed items; next price break is 25 items. Karin has price list. Has more performance based gear and can send samples/size options.

Karin will get a price point comparison between the companies. Maria to send out email with the websites so members can look at what they prefer and to get an idea of what members want to order.

Karin has some designs and order sheet from previous year's orders for T-shirts and visors. This is separate ordering from Wyn and Voler. Karin will scan the forms and send to Becky. Forms can be emailed to club members to see if there is an interest in ordering. We will allow 1-2 weeks for people to show interest and order.

There are ~30 BOCO hats in the trailer than can be first come first serve. \$25 for club members and \$20 for non-members. Matt mentioned it would be good if those can be brought to the bike time trial for members to purchase.

Matt will ask Mark to look into ability for club to have Venmo.

Matt will ask Mark to look into donation to the Clams Club (donation to show gratitude to allowing our club to store our trailer on their property).

Matt mentioned the trailer needs to be visited to see what maintenance or cleaning needs to be done.TBD.

March 15-CL POA pool is opening. Maria will check with Doug to see if he is interested in leading a swim clinic.

Lainie is awaiting USAT officer about confirmation of our insurance. Becky will forward her the insurance confirmation from last year.

Becky will look into the club website if yearly events/calendar can be listed. Currently they are listed on a rolling schedule. Maria will look into the Facebook group page if our yearly events can be listed there as well.
